

Clarkson as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, September, 1949, and recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book V, at page 32, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of the right-of-way of the New Bumcombe Road at Merritt's corner, and running thence with Merritt North 64-15 East 250.8 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence along Lot 2 North 22-16 West 166 feet, more or less, to point in line of Lot 2 and the corner of Clarkson; thence along the line of Clarkson South 64-30 West 285 feet, more or less, to point in center of Parker Road; thence with center of said road South 28-20 East 116 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence continuing with Parker Road South 39 East 54 feet to the point of EEGINNING and being the same land conveyed to William R.
