

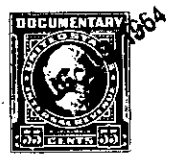

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), of the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-One and 06/100ths (\$121.06) Dollars, to Grantor in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter called "Grantee", all that certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the westerly corner of the H. W. Wilburn property and runs thence with the northeasterly line of the Mamie B. Fleming, et. al. property N 40-35 W 282.5 ft.; thence N 3-35 E 450.5 ft. to the southwesterly corner of the Corrine Page Sprouse property; thence with the southwesterly line of said property S 59-52 E 534.6 ft. to the northerly corner of the H. W. Wilburn property; thence with the northwesterly line of said property S 37-47 W 500.7 ft. to the BEGINNING, containing 4.1 acres as shown on print dated August 21, 1963, revised March 17, 1964, and revised May 21, 1964, marked File No. 24-02, copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; being the same property described in the deed from Drucilla Boozer to Hettie Singleton dated October 11, 1913 and recorded in Book of Deeds 71 at page 40, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
