A G R E E M E N T

Whereas the Jones Gap Road, for many years the principal route between Greenville and Brevard, North Carolina, is no longer maintained or used as a public road and,

Whereas Henry L. Ware and E. E. Dargan, as owners of land abutting upon said Jones Gap Road, have brought suit against the undersigned James P. Moore and Otis P. Moore to enforce their right to use that portion of said road running through lands of said Moores, for purposes of ingress and egress to their land and also seeking damages from said Moores resulting from their interference with such use; and

Now therefore, in consideration of said Henry L. Ware and E. E. Dargan dropping said suit, including their claim for damages, the said James P. Moore and Otis P. Moore, hereby recognize, on behalf of themselves and their heirs, assigns and successors in title, the existence of the right of the said Henry L. Ware and E. E. Dargan, their heirs, assigns, and successors in title, as owners of property abutting on said Jones Gap Road to freely use and maintain for use the same for ingress and egress to their lands at any and all times free from hinderance and obstruction.
