Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Joseph W. Gilliard

All that certain lot of land situated in Chick Springs
Township, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated
as Tract Number 1 on Plat of Estate of John Washington Gilliard,
made by Terry T. Dill, Reg. C. E. & L. S., dated September 1960,
said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book HHH, page 59. Said tract contains 10.0 acres,
more or less.

This deed is made pursuant to the Order of Court and is
for the purpose of obtaining partition in kind of land by and
between the plaintiff and defendants and is without any monetary
consideration.
