(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Garland Tolbert

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in _____ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina more particularly described as follows:

LOT No. 8, shown on plat of C. O. Riddle, R.S., dated February, 1964, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB, Page 19, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of an unnamed road, joint front corner of lots 8 and 9, and running thence along the line of said lots N. 73-54 W. 346.1 feet to an iron pin, in line of property of Mrs. Alvin Foster, joint rear corner of lots 8 and 9; thence along the line of the Foster property S. 17-16 W. 182.5 feet to a stone; thence S. 21-18 E. 176 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 86-30 E. 248.9 feet to an iron pin on the west side of said unnamed road, joint front corner of lots 7 and 8; thence along the west side of said unnamed road N. 16-06 E. 268 feet to the point of beginning.

It is understood and agreed that the road hereinabove referred to which is shown on said plat shall be designated and maintained as a public road for the benefit of the grantors and grantee and other members of the public.

The above-described property is a portion of the property owned by Lena Tolbert who died intestate on October 11, 1949, leaving the grantors and grantee herein as her sole heirs-at-law. This deed is made for the purpose of partitioning in kind certain property among said heirs. (See Apartment 579, File 19, office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C.).
