Vaughn and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the south side of U.S. Highway No. 29 and the north side of Moon Avenue in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being Lot No. 2 of the J.C. Moon Estate according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated June 12, 1947, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Moon Avenue, corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence along said Avenue, S. 82-52 E. 205.6 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of Lot No. 3, N. 4-50 E. 52 feet to an iron pin on the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 29; thence along said right-of-way line, N. 85-00 W. 205.6 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 1; thence along the line of Lot No. 1, S. 4-50 W. 44.9 feet to the beginning corner.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

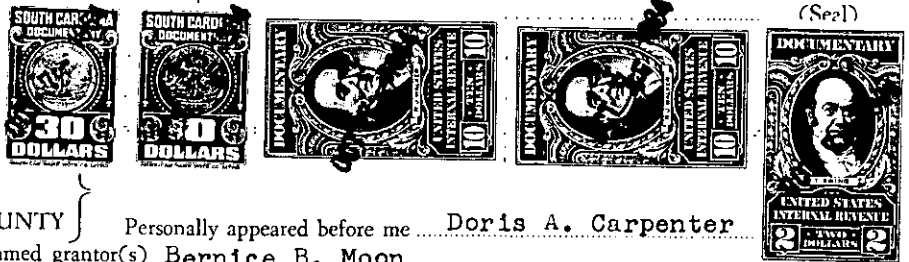
