

10th day of the next succeeding month, provided, however, that in no event shall the rental be less than Twenty-four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00) a year. During the term of this lease, Tenant will keep, in accordance with sound accounting practices, such records as are reasonably necessary and proper to reflect all sales of gasoline which would enter into a determination of the rents under the terms of this lease. Within ten (10) days after the expiration of each monthly period and when the rental is paid, Tenant will furnish Landlord a written statement verified by the Tenant, setting forth the amount of gasoline sold in the preceding month. If, at the expiration of the first "lease year" or any succeeding "lease year", the total of the monthly payments for that "lease year", based on one and one-half cents a gallon, does not total Twenty-four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00), the Tenant shall within ten (10) days after the close of said "lease year" pay to the Landlord the difference between the total of the monthly payments for the preceding twelve (12) months and Twenty-four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00). If, at any time during the term of this lease, the Tenant shall offer for sale on the premises any other fuel or substance as a substitute for gasoline in the operation of automobiles, trucks or other motor vehicles, then the Landlord and the Tenant shall first agree upon a reasonable percentage to be paid the Landlord in lieu of the amount it would have received on the sale of gasoline.

(2) Tenant agrees to operate and keep open for sales its service station on the leased premises not less than eighteen (18) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, legal holidays excepted. It is recognized that at times closing of the station may be necessary due to illness of the operator or due to a change of operators. Landlord agrees that a reasonable period, not to exceed two (2) weeks in any single "lease year", will be allowed as an exception to the eighteen (18) hours a day, seven (7) days a week open provisions of this contract, where such closing is due to the
