"All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Williamsburg Drive near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot number 3 on a plat of section 1 and 2 of Belle Meade Subdivision made by Piedmont Engineering Service June, 1954, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, at Pages 116 and 117, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Williamsburg Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3 and runs thence with the line of lot number 2 S. 78-27 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11-33 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lot number 4, N. 78-27 W. 150 feet to an iron pin being on the east side of Williamsburg Drive, thence along Williamsburg Drive N. 11-33 E. 70 feet to the BEGINNING corner."
