

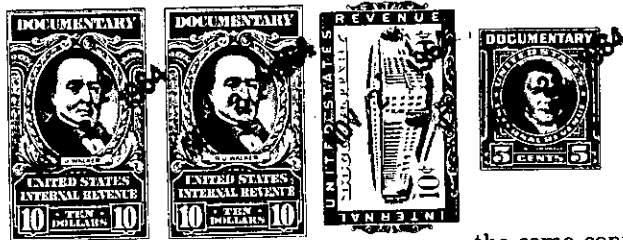
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D at Page 305, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
