

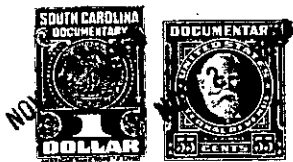

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Laylon Vinson,
his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina containing one half of one acre, (.5) more or
less. Adjoining lands of J. O. Lindley, Veldee Cooper, myself and
possibly others.

Having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at at
an iron pin, joint corner of J. O. Lindley, thence along public road
in a Southwesterly direction 100 feet to a stake; thence along new
line in a Southeasterly direction 186 feet to line of Veldee Cooper;
