ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northwest side of South Parker Road (sometimes known as Thompson Road), which leads from the New Buncombe Road through the Hillandale Golf Course in Paris Mountain Township and having, according to a survey made by Madison H. Woodward, Engineer, March 9, 1946, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Mix also conveyed an interest in this property to the grantor, Helen M. McNeill and James R. Mix by deed recorded in Deed BOOK D//, at rage 207, In the Office for Greenville County, S. C. It is the intent of the grantors to convey to the grantees all of the property that was acquired by W. B. Mix and Gertrude P. Mix from W. R. Dobbins, et al. by said deed R. Mix by deed recorded in Deed Book 577, at Page 284, in the R.M.C. - 297 - 448-3-16.2
