

privilege, in common with the owner, or owners, of each other of such tracts, his, her or their heirs and assigns, of taking water from that certain well shown and designated on said plat, as it is presently constructed, until such time as the same shall cease to produce water, or until such time it becomes possible for the owner, or owners, of each such tract, other than the tract remaining in Frank E. Friddle, his, hers, or their heirs and assigns to obtain water from a public supply. Such owners, as shall exercise such right and privilege shall bear, in equal shares, the costs and expenses of maintaining and operating said well water system.
