the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto William Thomas Griffith, Jr. and Pamela D. Griffith, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southerly side of Patti Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of a subdivision known as Staunton Heights, as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR, Page 167 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Patti Drive, joint front corner Lots Nos. 7 and 8 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 13-0 W. 185.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-08 E. 102.34 feet to an iron pin on the western side of a future street; thence with said street, N. 13-0 E. 153 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said street as it intersects with Patti Drive, following the curvature thereof, the chord of which being N. 32-0 W. 35.3 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of Patti Drive; thence with said drive, N. 77-0 W. 77 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to me by Dempsey Construction Company, Inc. by deed dated November 10, 1964 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 761, at Page 304.
