KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, William Robert Ward and Dorothy Olive Z. Ward,

in consideration of Thirteen Hundred and No/100 (\$1300.00)----- Dollars,  
and assumption of mortgage referred to below  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Georgia E. Greene, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 101, Section 2, Belmont Heights, as per plat thereof, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "GG", Page 99, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Kay Drive, joint front corner Lots Nos. 101 and 102; said iron pin being 100 feet in an easterly direction from the intersection of Dolores Street and Kay Drive; and running thence along Kay Drive N. 62-34 E. 93.6 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner Lots Nos. 100 and 101; thence N. 27-26 W. 142.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 100 and 101; thence S. 46-07 W. 96.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 101 and 102; thence S. 26-50 E. 115 feet to an iron pin on Kay Drive, the point of beginning.

As a part of the consideration hereof, the grantees agree to assume and pay, according to its terms, that certain note and mortgage given to H. V. Higley, as Administrator of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, and his successors in such office, said mortgage having a balance of \$ 8205.00, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgages Volume 720, Page 315.
