the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, whose principal office and post office address is Veterans Administration, Washington 25, D. C., and his successors in such office, as such.

ALL that lot of land with improvements on the South side of Lermann Drive, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 15 on a plat of Fairfield Acres, Section II, made by C. O. Riddle, Reg. L. S., dated January 1956, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book FF, Page 459, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:
