COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Lucile Lyles Wright

on or about the 22nd day of July in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and Sixty Four exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against William W. Wright, Jr.,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of December 1964, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Lucile Lyles Wright

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. J-3009)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Lucile Lyles Wright, all the right, title and interest of the defendant, William W. Wright, Jr., in and to the following described real estate:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, lying on the northwestern side of Lincoln School Circle and being known and designated as Lot No. 10, Block 1, of the property of Mrs. C. B. Loftis, according to a plat thereof prepared by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, August 8, 1955, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Lincoln School Circle joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 and running thence with the line of said lots, N. 49-50 W. 182 feet to an iron pin along the line of property of Lincoln School; thence with the line of the Lincoln School property N. 43-56 E. 90 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 53-26 E. 165.7 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Lincoln School Circle; thence with the Lincoln School Circle, N. 34-25 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner; and being the same conveyed to me by Violet M. Stallings, et al, by deed dated May 13, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 499 at Page 388."

This deed is made pursuant to the Order of Court and it is without any monetary consideration, and for that reason it is not necessary to place any revenue stamps hereon.

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
