AGREEMENT TO CLOSE A STREET

WHEREAS, a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book EEE at Page 3, being designated as the property of R. B. Vaughn's estate, shows a street named Lowland Drive, said street abutting the property of the Arthur Hood estate for 331.4 feet in a southerly direction off of Fairview Road; and,

WHEREAS, A. B. Hood, or Arthur Hood, died testate in the year 1948 leaving all of his property, including that above referred as Arthur Hood estate, to his wife, Ida, for life, with remainder to his named children, share and share alike, Bessie Hood Dill, James Hood and Laura Hood Terry; and,

WHEREAS, the Probate Court records for Greenville County, File 835-11, reveal that Ida Hood deceased in 1963, thereby vesting title to the aforesaid property in the aforesaid children.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to us in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the grantors herein do hereby release and relinquish any right, title or claim they may have in and to the aforesaid street and hereby agree that said street has never been accepted by them or to their knowledge by any governmental instrumentality, and that they hereby further agree that said street shall hereafter forever be considered to be closed.

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
