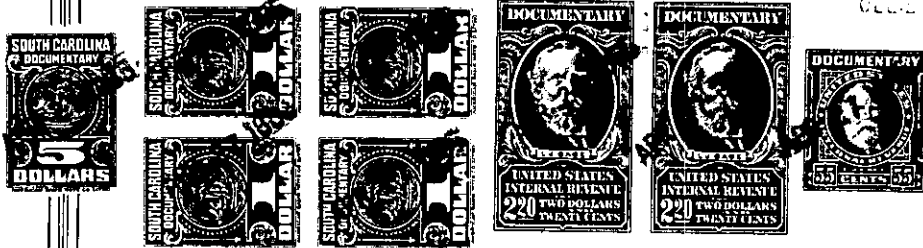

County, State of South Carolina, described as follows:
