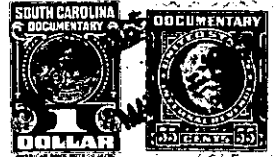

ALL the undivided two-thirds (2/3) interest of Frances Elaine Burton,
Stephen Graham Burton, Marsha Roberta Burton and Carroll Jean Burton
in and to:

ALL that lot of land situate on the Southwest side of Meadow Street
(formerly Spruce Street) in the City of Greenville in Greenville County,
South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 15 on plat of Liberia, recorded
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat
Book C, Page 36, and having according to said plat, the following metes
and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Meadow Street at the
joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15 and runs thence along the line of
Lot 14, S. 32-00 W., 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-00 W., 25 feet
