the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto ROBERT E. JOHNSON, HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 20 Carlton Drive, on a plat of Pine Valley Estates, Section 1, by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated February, 1960, said plat being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book MM at Page 138, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Carlton Drive, joint front corner of Lot Nos. 19 and 20; thence N. 28-44 E. 145 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lot Nos. 19 and 20; thence N. 55-17 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 28-44 W. 146 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Carlton Drive; thence along Carlton Drive 3. 55-51 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to restrictions of record in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 644, Page 389.
