acres, more or less, on the Blackberry Valley Road, about seven miles
north of Greenville Court House having the following metes and bounds,
as represented by a plat made by W. A. Hester, August 8, 1935;

BEGINNING in the center of Blackberry Valley Road, at the corner
of Edd Simpson's line, and running thence with Simpson's line, N. 36° W.
31.25 chains to a stake, at Wynn's corner; thence with Wynn's line,
