"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one mile east of Brushy Creek Baptist Church, containing nine acres, and being parts of Tracts Nos. 7 and 8 of the J. D. Burnett Estate, Survey and plat by H. S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated October 23, 1939, and having the following metes and bounds:
