

20 feet and extending from the eastern edge of the Farris Bridge Road approximately 440 feet and shown more particularly on the attached drawing which is made a part hereof. The right of way is granted for the purposes of operating, maintaining, replacing and adding to the aforementioned six-inch water main which is being installed by the grantor at its expense and the service lines from the said water main to the water meters and for the purpose of installing and operating and maintaining water meters and other necessary appurtenances to said water line. After installation of the water line, the grantee shall have the obligation of maintaining such line, but the entire cost of construction and the installation of the water line shall be the expense of the grantor.

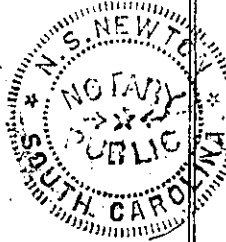
