I, Charles L. Staton,

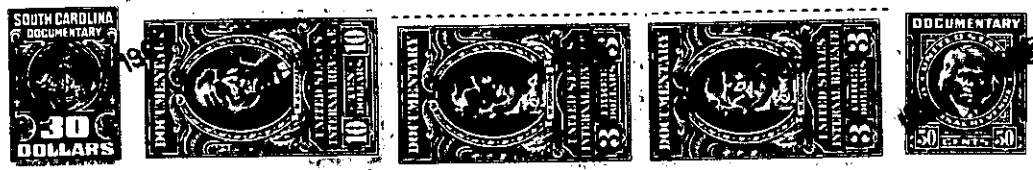
in consideration of Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$14,950.00)-----Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto

John P. Pew, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, on the southeastern side of Tanglewood Drive being known and
designated as Lot No. 51 of Tanglewood Subdivision, plat of which is recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, Plat Book "GG", at Page 57, and having,
according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Tanglewood Drive, joint front
corner of Lots Nos. 50 and 51, and running thence S. 50-20 E. 161.3 feet to an iron
pin; thence across the rear line of Lot No. 51 S. 64-55 W. 39 feet to an iron pin; thence
continuing with the rear line of Lot No. 51 S. 39-00 W. 84 feet to an iron pin; thence with
the common line of Lots Nos. 51 and 52 N. 50-32 W. 143.7 feet to an iron pin on the
southeastern side of Tanglewood Drive; thence with said Drive N. 38-38 E. 120 feet to an
iron pin, the point of beginning.
