Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of North Main Street approximately 60 feet Southward from the South side of College Street, and said pin being on the Southeast corner of a lot now or formerly belonging to The Realty Company of Greenville, S. C., and running thence along said lot, N. 72 degrees W. 130 feet to a stake on a alley; thence with the said alley, S. 18 degrees W. 20 feet to a stake on the corner of a lot conveyed by the late Alexander MacBeth, Trustee, to W. A. Chandler, by deed dated April 4, 1924, and recorded in the RMC Office for said County and State, in Deed Book 102, at Page 93; thence along line of the last mentioned lot, S. 72 degrees E. 130 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Main Street; thence with said street, N. 18 degrees E. 20 feet to the beginning corner.

An undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the West side of North Main Street, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of North Main Street, at the Northeast corner of a lot formerly conveyed by Harold D. Burgiss to Cleveland and Brawley, and running thence with the line of said North Main Street, N. 18 E. 20 feet to an iron pin, corner of property now or formerly of W. H. Keith; thence with his line, N. 72 W. 130 feet to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence along the East side of said alley, S. 18 W. 20 feet to an iron pin, the Northwest corner of said lot of land formerly conveyed by Harold D. Burgiss to Cleveland and Brawley; thence with the line of said lot, S. 72 E. 130 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same land conveyed to my husband, T. B. Reeves, by deed of John McSween, dated April 13, 1936, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 184, Page 266.

An undivided one-fourth interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 4 and 5 as shown on a plat of property of Charlotte R. Smith Mallard, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book F, at Page 169, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

Lot No. 4: Beginning at a point at the Northwestern intersection of North Main and West North Streets, and running thence along the West side of North Main Street, N. 20-00 E. 19 feet to a point in the center of an 8 inch partition wall; thence along the center of said 8 inch wall, N. 69-50 W. 100 feet to a point in the Western face of a 13 inch rear wall; thence along the Western face of said wall, S. 20-00 W. 19 feet to a point on the North side of West North Street; thence along West North Street, S. 69-50 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

Lot No. 5: Beginning at a point on the North side of West North Street, at the Western face of the rear wall of Lot No. 4 above described, and running thence N. 20-00 E. 75 feet to a point at the Northwest corner of Lot No. 1, as shown on said plat; thence N. 69-50 W. 30 feet to a point in the Eastern side of a 10 foot alley; thence along the Eastern side of said alley, S. 20-03 W. 75 feet to a point in the Northern side of West North Street; thence with said West North Street, S. 69-50 E. 30 feet 3/4 inches to the point of beginning.
