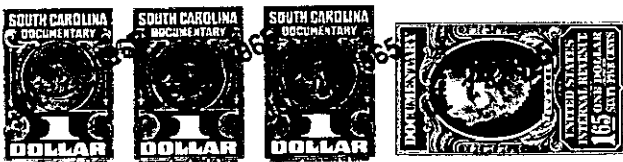

in consideration of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) and no/100--- Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Lollie Gibson, and his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at Paris, north of the old National Highway, and known and designated as Lots Numbers 61, 62 and 63 on Plat of the property of E. M. Wharton made by R. E. Dalton, Engr. and recorded in Plat Book "F", at page 208, RMC Office for Greenville County, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on eastern side of Street leading from old National Highway northward, on southern line of Right of Way of P. & N. Rwy., and running thence N. 46-33 E. 110 feet along the line of said Right of Way, to point on line of the Alfred Tanner property; thence with the line of said property, S. 43-08 E. 98.9 feet to point, corner of Lot No. 64; thence S. 60-16 W. 129.8 feet along line of said Lot No. 64, to point on said Street; thence N. 29-44 W. 70 feet along the eastern side of said Street, to the point of beginning.
