"ALL THAT CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS TRACT NO. 6 IN THE DIVISION OF THE LANDS OF THE LATE JOSEPHINE WALKER. THE SAID TRACT OF LAND CONTAINS NINETEEN AND ONE-TENTH (19 1/10) ACRES, MORE OR LESS, BEING SITUATED IN OAKLAWN TOWNSHIP, STATE AND COUNTY AFORESAID, ADJOINING LANDS OF H. P. BEAM. ALSO TRACTS NO. 5 AND NO. 7 OF SAID DIVISION. A PLAT MADE BY W. E. ADKINS AND B. F. WIGINGTON, WILL MORE FULLY DESCRIBE THE LAND HEREBY CONVEYED." LESS, HOWEVER, THE TRACT OF LAND CONVEYED BY S. A.
