Smith, E.S. Guest, Ralph W. Blakely, Harry L. Cunningham, and Charles V. Verner, County Commissioners, constituting the Greenville County Board of Commissioners, for and in consideration of the circumstances herein related and the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release all of Greenville County's right, title and interest, unto Lowell W. Campbell and Ora Campbell, to the following described property, to-wit:

> All that piece, parcel or lot of land near Greenville, South Carolina, being a portion of Lots No. 32 and 35 of the property shown on a plat of L.W. and Ora Campbell, made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated March 10th, 1952, situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
