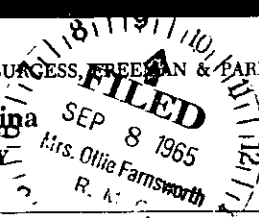


State of South Carolina GREENVILLE COUNTY TITLE TO REAL ESTATE Know All Men by These Presents:



That EDWARD D. SLOAN hereafter referred to as Grantor, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred & no/100 (\$3,600.00)-----DOLLARS, paid to Grantor by SLOAN CONSTRUCTION CO., INC., hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantee

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the west side of the Old Greenville-Piedmont National Highway running between Greenville and Piedmont, S. C., in Gantt Township, Greenville County, being shown as Tract No. 1 on plat of property of Luther A. Bragg, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, July 19, 1947, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 111, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the Old Greenville-Piedmont National Highway at joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, said pin being 284.7 feet south of the southwest corner of the intersection of Lakeside Road and the Old Greenville-Piedmont National Highway, and running thence along the line of Tract 2, N. 71-17 W. 424.8 feet to iron pin in the center of the main track of the Piedmont & Northern Railway; thence with the center of the main track of Piedmont & Northern Railway, S. 19-45 W. 279.2 feet to iron pin; thence S. 71-00 E. along McHugh property 381.8 feet to iron pin in the center of Old Greenville-Piedmont National Highway; thence with center of said highway, N. 29-42 E. 235.3 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with said highway, N. 24-10 E. 49.4 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 2.60 acres, more or less.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of R. F. Melton dated January 30, 1960, recorded February 22, 1960, in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 645, at page 59.

AND Grantor does hereby bind Grantor and Grantor's Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto Grantee and Grantee's Heirs/Successors and Assigns against Grantor and Grantor's Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
