

Lessor covenants that Lessee upon paying the rent in the manner herein provided and performing the covenants aforesaid, shall and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and enjoy said premises for the term aforesaid.

Should said premises be so damaged by the elements or other unavoidable casualty as to render them untenanted, this lease shall immediately cease and terminate and all advance payments of rents, if any, covering periods subsequent to the date of such damage shall be promptly refunded to Lessee.

Lessee shall have the right to renew this lease, upon the same terms and conditions, for a further period of ~~Three~~ (3) ~~years~~ years from the date of the expiration of the primary term hereof, by giving written notice of its intention so to renew not less than Sixty (60) days before the expiration of said primary term.

It is further understood and agreed that the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company will erect a fence to enclose the entire lot and upon termination of the lease, the land will be tilled and reseeded in grass.

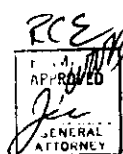

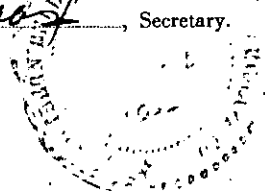
