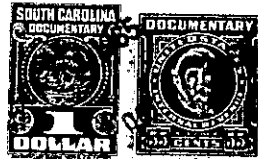

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Charles Earl King

In consideration of Three Hundred and No/100----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto James A. Cooley, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, State and County aforesaid, bounded on the West by lands of Belton Light and Power Co. (originally B. M. McGee lands) and on the South by lands of Belton Light and Power Co., originally E. A. Smythe lands, and on the East and South by lands of Julius Walton, having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone corner between Belton Light and Power Co. lands (B.M. McGee lands) and Belton Light and Power Co. (E. A. Smythe lands) and Julius Walton lands, and running thence N. 80-45 E., 300 feet to a stake; thence N. 9-15 W., 150 feet to a stake; thence S. 80-45 W. 323 feet to a stake; thence S. 31-30 E., 85 feet to a stone; thence S. 1-30 E., 72 feet to beginning corner, said tract containing one and three-one-hundredth acres, more or less, and being the same property conveyed to grantor by Maxine H. Drake by deed dated July 15, 1964 and recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 753, Page 231.
