

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and no/100-----

Dollars,

to me paid by the said John P. Hudson

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said John P. Hudson

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Butler Township, about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles west from Pelham lying south from the Bennetts Bridge Road, being bounded on the north by lands of Mrs. Mary E. Edwards, on the east by Mrs. Mary E. Edwards, on the south by lands of Mrs. Fowler, and on the west by other lands of myself.

BEGINNING on an iron pin, on the Fowler line and joint corner of Mrs. Edwards' tract and runs thence with the Edwards' line, N. 12-00 W. 514 feet to an iron pin, Edwards corner; thence with another Edwards line, S. 83-55 W. 400 feet to an iron pin on the said line; thence S. 7-20 E. 522 feet to an iron pin on the Fowler line; thence with the Fowler line, S. 89-40 E. 450 feet to the beginning corner containing 5.3 acres, more or less."
