WHEREAS, R. L. Haden, by deed dated January 24, 1952 conveyed to The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., the below described property, in trust, for certain uses and purposes fully set forth in said deed recorded on February 21, 1952 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deeds Volume 451, at page 447, and

WHEREAS, The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., merged with The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, and under Clause 14 of said Trust Agreement, The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C., became trustee under the terms of said trust, and

WHEREAS, under Clause 16 of said Trust Agreement the trustee was directed to convey the below described property to the Grantees herein when the youngest child, Mary Gray Haden, now Mary Gray Haden Keenan, reached twenty-five years of age, and

WHEREAS, Mary Gray Haden Keenan became twenty-five years of age on August 16, 1965, and this deed is made in compliance with the terms of said trust and to terminate the said trust.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C., as trustee under the R. L. Haden trust deed, dated January 24, 1952 in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollar to the Grantor herein paid at and before sealing of these presents by the Grantees receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further compliance with the terms of said trust, has granted, bargained, sold, released, quitclaimed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, release, and quitclaim unto Robert Lee Haden, Jr., William Whitner Haden and Mary Gray Haden Keenan, their heirs and assigns, forever;
