in consideration of ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100-----(\$1,750.00)----- Dollars,

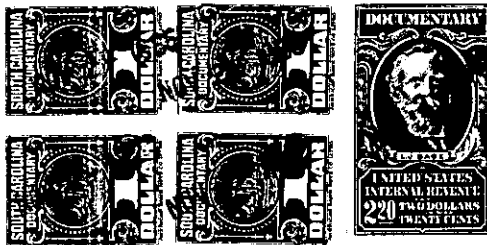

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 19 of the Property of Wm. R. Timmons, Jr., according to a plat of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book XX at Page 9, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southeastern side of Lilac Street at the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 20 and running thence with the Southeastern side of Lilac Street S 58-53 W 130. feet to a point; thence following the curvature of the Eastern intersection of Lilac Street with Penarth Street (the chord of which is S 13-53 W 28.3 feet) to a point; thence with the Northeastern side of Penarth Street S 31-07 E 151.3 feet to a point at the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 27; thence N 58-53 E 150 feet to a point at the rear corner of Lot 19; thence N 31-07 W 171.3 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

THIS deed is executed subject to existing and recorded restrictions and rights-of-way.
