KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Murray Dewitt Woodward, of Greenville, South Carolina, do hereby constitute and appoint my father, Murray F. Woodward, of Greenville, South Carolina, as my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead, with full power to have and to exercise the following powers and authorities:

1. To sell or exchange and convey any property, whether real, personal or mixed, which I may now own or hereafter acquire, specifically including stocks, bonds or securities.
2. To sign checks withdrawing or transferring funds from any bank in which money may be deposited in my name, and to accept, collect and endorse any checks, drafts or instruments for the payment of money.
3. To borrow money and execute notes or other instruments securing the re-payment, and to pledge as security therefor any stocks, bonds, securities or property which I may own, and/or to mortgage any real or personal property which I may own in order to secure said loans.
4. To collect any monies which may become due me and to give receipts therefor.
5. To be my lawful proxy, and to vote any stock or security I may own, or hereafter acquire, and to exercise
