ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the north side of Merrilat Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S.C., being shown as Lot No. 74 on a revised plat of Map No. N-2 of Sans Souci Heights, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, page 59, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
