Bagwell (the record of whose estate is filed in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment 95, File 7) died intestate August 6, 1909 leaving as his only heirs-at-law the grantor and the grantee herein, their mother, Minnie C. Bagwell, and their sister, Elizabeth D. Bagwell (now Elizabeth D. Bagwell Jones); Minnie C. Bagwell died April 19, 1940 leaving a Will which is on file in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment 446, File 18; the grantor and the grantee herein and their sister, Elizabeth D. Bagwell (now Elizabeth D. Bagwell Jones), as devisees under the Will of their mother, Minnie C. Bagwell, have entered into an agreement dated <u>for Greenville County</u>, 1966, and recorded or to be recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, pursuant to which the grantor and the grantee herein and their said sister acknowledge that each of them is vested with an undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to the within described property, said one-third (1/3) interest of the grantor herein being the same interest hereby conveyed to the grantee herein.
