KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Lewis L. Alexander, Jr., of Greenville County,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto Colon James Goode, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as Lot 34 of Broadmoor as shown by plat thereof made by Piedmont Engineering Service dated July, 1960 and recorded in Plat Book RR at Page 47, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Woodbury Circle at the joint front corner of Lots 33 and 34 and running thence with the eastern side of Woodbury Circle, N. 0-38 W., 105 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 34 and 35; thence with the line of Lot 35, N. 89-22 E., 160 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot 22; thence with the rear line of Lots 22 and 23, S. 0-38 E., 105 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 33; thence with the line of Lot 33, S. 89-22 W., 160 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by S. N. Berry and Nell C. Berry by deed dated September 30, 1964, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 753, at Page 585.
