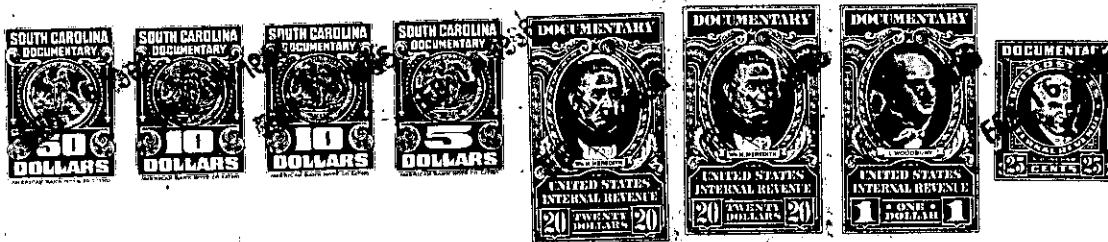

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

SUN OIL COMPANY

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being in shape a triangle, containing one and four-tenths (1.4) acres, more or less, and being bounded and measuring as follows: Commencing at a concrete marker at the intersection of the northern right-of-way of S. C. Road #492 (Pelham Road) and the eastern right-of-way of Highway I-85, and proceeding N 68° 30' E four hundred sixty-six and five-tenths (466.5') feet along the right-of-way of Highway I-85 to an iron; thence S 29° 10' W four hundred twelve and two-tenths (412.2') feet along property now or formerly of Smith to an iron; thence N 50° 58' W three hundred (300') feet along the northern right-of-way of S. C. Road #492 (Pelham Road) to the point of beginning, as shown on a plat prepared for Sun Oil Company by William Wingfield dated December 22, 1965; being a portion of the tract conveyed to the grantors by deed of Hillsboro, Inc. dated May 18, 1964, recorded in Deed Book 750, at page 77.
