I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Grace Parker Foister, individually and as General Guardian

complaint in the County Court for the County aforesaid, against

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard
on the 21st day of March 1966,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and
decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to Grace Parker Foister

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of
Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$1,066.66

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Grace Parker Foister, all the right title and interest of the
minor defendant, John Clifford Parker, Jr., in and to the following
described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with buildings and
improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a part of what was
formerly known as Riverside Lands; said lot being known and designated
on plat thereof made by Carter & Pringle, Surveyors, recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and being known as Lot No. 7,
Block Z, fronting 50 feet on Highlawn Avenue and having a depth of
125 feet to an alley.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and
State aforesaid, near Monaghan Mill and being known as Riverside.
Said lot being known and designated as Lot No. 8 on plat of said lands
made by Carter & Pringle and being in Block Z and having a frontage
of 50 feet on Highlawn Avenue and having a depth of 125 feet to an
alley. Said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book A, at page 323."

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
