KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. Alvin Gilreath, of Greenville County, South Carolina, do hereby constitute, nominate and appoint my son, ~~James~~ J. Alvin Gilreath, Jr., as my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead, with full power to have and to exercise the following powers and authorities:

1. To sell and convey any real estate or personal property which I may own, or hereafter acquire, with specific authority to execute deeds of conveyance.

2. To sign checks, withdrawing or transferring funds from any bank in which money may be deposited in my name, and to accept, collect and endorse any checks, drafts or instruments for the payment of money to me.

3. To borrow money and execute notes and mortgages therefor, and to pledge as security for the payment of said notes any property which I may now own, or which may be hereafter acquired, in connection with my business.

4. To collect any and all sums due to me and to execute receipts therefor.

5. To manage and generally control my property and business and to execute any and all instruments necessary or expedient for that purpose, the same as I might do if
