District of Greenville County now desires to quitclaim and confirm

conform with the other deeds conveying property to said Church.

meeting on January 11, 1966,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The School District of Greenville

in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and No/100 (\$5.00) Dollars  
and the premises hereinabove stated - - - - -  
to us - - - - - in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by J. Ralph Singleton, Earl Owens, J. T. McKee, Frank Cagle, and D. E.  
Tollison, as Deacons of the Eastview Baptist Church, Pelzer, South Carolina,  
quitclaimed confirmed  
(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Ralph Singleton, Earl  
Owens, J. T. McKee, Frank Cagle, and D. E. Tollison, as Deacons of  
the Eastview Baptist Church, Pelzer, South Carolina, their successors,  
heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the eastern side  
of Greenville Road, containing 1.68 acres, more or less, and more  
fully represented by a plat made by William F. Lee, dated July 5,  
1911, to which reference may be had and being the same property conveyed  
to the Trustees of School District # 4.G. by deed recorded in Deed  
Volume 13, at Page 296.

ALSO:  
ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Oaklawn Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the eastern side  
of Greenville Road, containing .30 acres and more fully represented  
by a plat made by William F. Lee, dated July 5, 1911, to which reference  
may be had for a more definite description and being the same property  
conveyed to the Trustees of School District # 4.G. by deed recorded  
in Deed Volume 13, at Page 371.

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Oaklawn  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 1  
acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds:
