the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto

ROY A. MARCH, his heirs and assigns, an undivided one-half interest in
and to the following described land:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, situate on the northwest side of Dunham Bridge Road
(S. C. Highway 81), being known and designated as Lot No. 19, Block 1, Sheet
250, of the County Block Book, and being more particularly described as
follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of South Carolina
Highway 81, at the corner of property heretofore conveyed to Ralph March, and
running thence with the line of said property, N. 41 - 35 W., 290.9 feet to
an iron pin; thence N. 76 - 59 E. 243.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43 -
30 W., 75.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50 - 20 E. 208.5 feet to a pin in
the center of the Greenville-Anderson Highway (Dunham Bridge Road); thence
with the center of said road as the line, the following courses: S. 43 - 13
W., 100 feet and S. 53 - 13 W., 54.2 feet to an iron pin at the beginning
corner.
