

8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12-12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

The manufacture, purchase or other means of acquisition, and sale or other means of disposal, of pneumatic tire deflation signal devices, and related and allied accessories;

The manufacture, purchase or other means of acquisition, and sale or other means of disposal, of any and all trailer, automobile and truck attachments and accessories;

The purchase, or other means of acquisition, and the holding, of (Letters) patents, franchises and licensee rights under Letters Patent, Trade Marks and the like, covering such devices as those aforesaid, and those related thereto or allied therewith, with the power to sell or otherwise dispose of, said patents, trade marks, franchises and licensee rights;

Together with all other rights, powers and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of South Carolina and of the United States of America upon business corporations, without specific mention thereof.

9. Provisions which the incorporators elect to include in the articles of incorporation are as follows:
