Those two pieces, parcels or strips of land situate, lying and being in or near Taylors, Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Burlington Industries, Inc., Taylors, South Carolina," made by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, Greenville, South Carolina, July 15, 1965, and revised November 19, 1965:
