BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Pimlico Road at the joint front corner of Lots No. 454 and 455 and runs thence along the line of Lot No. 454 N 14-40 W 216.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N 59-05 E 134.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 456 S 15-45 E 205.5 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Pimlico Road; thence along Pimlico Road S 51-16 W 84.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Pimlico Road (the chord being S 61-08 W 58.6 feet) to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the restrictive covenants recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 753, page 571, and is subject to the drainage easement along the north-east side of said lot as shown on the recorded plat.
