Whereas, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, the City of Greenville is authorized to levy taxes and assess property within the limits of said city for taxation, and upon default in the payment thereof to issue under the hand and seal of the Clerk of the City Council of the City of Greenville an execution directed to some officer designated for the collection of delinquent taxes, requiring and commanding him to levy the same by distress and sale of so much of the defaulting taxpayers' estate, real, personal, or both, as may be sufficient to satisfy the taxes and charges thereon so levied and assessed; and further that said officer may take possession of such property and after due advertisement, sell and dispose of the same as in such cases provided by law, make titles thereto and put the purchaser in possession,

and lodged with the Delinquent Tax Collector of said City.

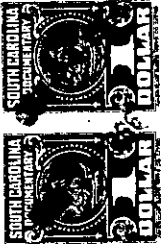

Now, therefore, I, Harry G. Hopkins, Delinquent Tax Collector for the City of Greenville, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the sum of Seven Hundred Ninety-Five and No/100 -

have granted, bargained, sold and released and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. Mack Parkins his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 5, Block 4, Block Book Sheet 87, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Northeast corner of the intersection of Nichols Street and Robins Street, and running thence along the eastern side of Robins Street 99.7 feet to a point; thence in a southeasterly direction 100 feet to a point; thence in a southwesterly direction 101 feet to a point on the northern side of Nichols Street; thence along the northern side of Nichols Street 99 feet to the point of beginning.



Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anyway incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said C. Mack Parkins, his heirs and assigns forever.
