Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$2500.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Rilla B. Mahon

ALL that lot of land with improvements in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Southeastern side of
Willis Avenue, being shown as the Southwestern one-half of Lot
No. 29, Section B, on a plat of the Property of H. H. Willis
& Alice M. Willis, made by W. J. Riddle, R. L. S., dated November,
1939, and recorded in the RMC Office for said County and State in
Plat Book J, page 151, and having according to said plat the
following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Willis Avenue
at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 28 and 29, and running thence
S. 67 E., 252 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots
Nos. 28, 19, and 20; thence N. 36-15 E., 100 feet along the rear
line of Lot No. 19, to a point at the joint rear corners of Lots
Nos. 18 and 19; thence in a Northwesternly direction, 279 feet to a
point on the Southeastern side of Willis Avenue; thence S. 19-32 W.,
