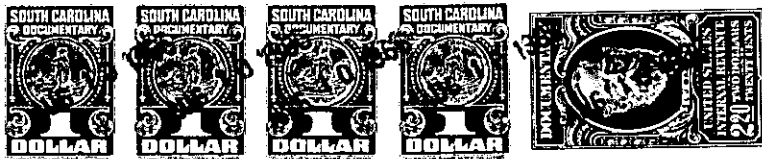
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, T. N. Allen

in consideration of Two Thousand -- -- -- -- -- (\$2,000.00) -- -- -- -- -- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Dr. William R. White and Mary K. White their Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid, Fairview Township, on the North side of the Jenkins Bridge Road, containing ten and one-half (10.5) acres, more or less, with the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of said Jenkins Bridge Road, corner with lands of D. M. White & Cordelia White, and running thence with the joint line of the said D. M. & Cordelia White in a Northerly direction 8.6 Chains to an iron pin, joint corner with the said White land; thence along the joint line of the said White land in a Westerly direction 16.4 Chains to an iron pin on Creek; thence in a Southerly direction along said Creek 6.0 Chains to an iron stake, corner with John Henderson; thence with the Henderson line and that of Willie Clinkscales in an Easterly direction 12.9 Chains to an iron pin; thence in a Southerly direction 3.6 Chains to an iron pin in the Northern edge of said Jenkins Bridge Road; thence with said Road in an Easterly direction 3.0 Chains to an iron pin, the point of beginning, and bounded by lands of D. M. White & Cordelia White, Rabun Creek, John Henderson, Willie Clinkscales and the said Jenkins Bridge Road.
This being all the balance and remainder of lands originally owned by the Grantor on the Jenkins Bridge Road.
