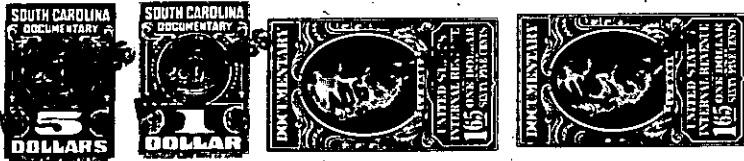
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 145, on plat of City View, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book A, at page 460, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on corner of 19th Street, (formerly known as New Cut Road and also as Bramlett Road) and McDade Street and running thence with McDade Street N. 1/2 E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 144 on said plat; thence with the line of said Lot No. 144, N. 89-30 E. 150 feet to a 10-foot alley; thence with said alley S. 1/2 W. 30 feet to a stake on 10th Street; thence with said 10th Street, 150 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed dated November 1st, 1958, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 609, at page 361.

All improvements situate on said premises including, but not limited to three storage tanks, two Wayne electric computing pumps, and one Gilbarco electric computing pump,
